Please ensure that your child brings their reading book **and** reading diary to school **every day**. It's vitally important that children learn to read fluently as quickly as possible. Inevitably, fluent readers will learn more, because they can read and gain knowledge for themselves so our challenge is to open this door of opportunity for all of our children. Evidence suggests that children who read for enjoyment every day not only perform better in reading tests than those who don't, but also develop a broader vocabulary, increased general knowledge and a better understanding of other cultures.
