### ATTENDANCE

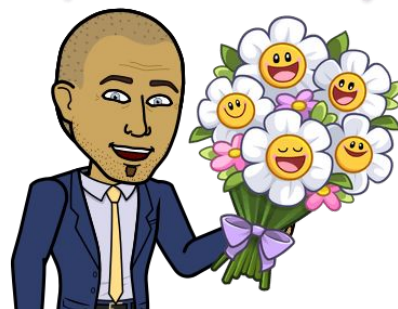
